Opening Address at Givlife Centre*

Givlife was established in Cannington in 2008 by a group of people concerned about the homeless and lonely people in the area. The growing evidence around the number of homeless youth and the increase in their distress levels, creating high risk situations in the community confirmed the need for help.

Givlife's mission is to provide relief to these people who are in situations of suffering, destitution, sickness or distress, irrespective of race, creed or religious belief.

DEVELOPING LIFE SKILLS

Developing skills and knowledge opens opportunities. Givlife runs regular life skills and rehabilitation seminars to assist integration to the community and build self esteem. It also runs workshops in various skills, such as music development and sound engineering. Conferences are held regularly for the local community in need.

Sustainable change is brought about through on-going support and guidance. Givlife provides mentoring services to people who attend workshops and events, ensuring the new found skills and attitudes develop.

RELATIONSHIPS

It is through relationships that we can grow and build our lives. Givlife works with young people, women, men, ethnically isolated and elderly to build relationships that are life giving. Social evenings for the culturally and physically isolated provide an opportunity to meet and share with others from similar backgrounds.

For example, the Friday Life Centre is a safe place for young people to just 'hang'—for 11-18 yr olds from varied socio-economic backgrounds and educational levels struggling with life through homelessness, low self-esteem, abuse, addictions and lack of relationships—Qualified supervisors are always in place.
